

Blanket Measuring Instructions

To measure for most blankets, use a tape measure from center of horse's chest to side of his tail.

For **Weatherbeetas new Freestyle blankets**, measure to the widest part of the flank and end where the horse's rump curves back to the tail. Here are some guidelines for average blanket sizes:

For **Horseware products**, Measure the distance from the **centre of the chest** across the point shoulder to the **centre of the tail**. **Take 4"** off for a **Turnout** and **7"** off for a **stable**. Using this guideline will mean that your horse will probably require **one size larger for his turnout rug** than for his stable rug. Horseware rugs are sized in three inch increments. This measurement refers to the distance from the centre of the chest to the rear of the quarters where you expect the rug to finish.

The chart below is a guideline to blanket sizing.

10 Hands (small pony) - 48 to 54

11 Hands (pony) - 56

12 Hands (pony) - 60

13 Hands (pony) - 64

14 Hands (yearling) - 66

14.2 Hands (2 year old or lg pony) - 70

15 Hands (small horse) - 72

15.2 Hands (QH type) - 74

16 Hands (TB, saddlebred) - 76

16.2 Hands (Warmblood) - 78 to 80

17 Hands (Warmblood) - 82 to 87
